Wonky Stars

Fabrics:

Bright colors (patterned or plain) for stars White Background

Directions

Fabric Needed:

- 8 5-inch squares of White fabric
- 1 10-inch square of colored fabric

Cutting:

Cut the colored 10-inch square in half (5 inches x 10 inches)

Cut one of these halves again into 5-inch squares



Set aside one colored 5-inch square for center and 4 5-inch white squares for the corners Making the Star Points:

Lay the colored square (right side down) on a white 5- inch square.

Lay from center of one edge diagonally to about 2/3 down the side



Stitch ¼ inch along the colored square,

Press the colored piece back over the white corner and trim along the edge of the white

*** Hint*** it is easier to trim these pieces with a scissors than with a cutter.

Repeat with the second side of the white square.

*** Hint*** trim carefully as it will take all of your 10 inch square of colored to make all points

Vary the length of the points being created on these for squares

Repeat until four of the white squares have the star points sewn and pressed

Trim from the back side to 5-inch squares.

Overlap the points where they meet at center of the square



Finishing:

Assemble the pieces make a 9-patch block
