

VQG 2017 Mystery Quilt

Finished Block Size: 22 1/2" x 22 1/2"

(Requirements based on at least 41" of usable fabric without selvages)


Block Assembly Instructions — Step 1

Definitions:

3-Patch Block



9-Patch Block



For demonstration purposes, the dark fabric is contrast fabric #1 and the white is the background fabric. Press toward the dark fabric.

Full Size and Twin Quilt:

1. Using the 2 inch strips, sew 3 strips sets together using 2 Contrast Fabric #1 strips and one background strip to as show in the 3-patch block above. Cut the strips into 5" sections. You will need 24 each of the 3-patch blocks.
2. Using 2 inch strips, sew two strips sets of Background-Contrast #1-Background together. Cut these strips into 2 inch sections. Cut one background strip in half and one Contrast fabric #1 strip in half. Stitch together for the 3-patch strip and cut eight 2" sections from that half strip. You should get 20 from each full strip set. You will need a total of 48 of these sections all together.
3. Sew one strip set of Contrast #1-Background-Contrast #1. Cut that into 2" sections. You should get 20 sections. From the half strips left from step 2, cut the contrast fabric #1 strip in half again and sew together with the background strip. Cut four 2" sections from that partial strip set. You will need a total of 24 of these sections.
4. Sew the sections from steps 2 and 3 together to make the 9-patch blocks. You should have 24 9-patch blocks when finished.

Baby Quilt:

1. Using the 2 inch strips, sew a strip together using two contrast fabric #1 strips and one background strip. Subcut this strip in four each 5" sections and four each 2" sections.
2. Cut the remaining background strip in half and sew together with a contrast fabric #1 strip. From this strip, cut eight each 2" sections.
3. Sew the 2" sections together to make four 9-patch blocks.
