

## April 2024 BOM - Sue's Shoofly

Purple, Yellow, and Easter Colors

12 ½" unfinished block

### Cut:

\*Half Square Triangles (HSTs): Two 6 1/2" squares purple & two 6 1/2" squares yellow

\*Scrappy Rectangles: 2 ½" wide scrappy strips of yellows and purples

Can be cut from 2 ½" squares or strips and pieced to equal four 2 ½ x 5 ½ strips

\*Quarter Square Triangle (QST): Two 3 ½" squares – one each yellow and purple

### Piece:

HSTs: Draw a diagonal line on the two lighter HSTs. Place a yellow and purple HST right sides together. Sew ¼" on either side of the diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. You now have 2 HSTs. Press to the dark side. **Square the HSTs to 5 ½"**. Repeat with the other set. You now have the 4 corner HSTs. Purple is on the inside of the corner, and yellow is on the outside of the corner.

Scrappy Rectangles: Piece the strips cut for the scrappy rectangles (see pic) to make four 2 ½ x 5 ½" rectangles. Press each in one direction. They don't need to line up with any other seams.

QST: Draw a diagonal line on the two 3.5" purple and yellow squares. Sew ¼" on either side, cut on the diagonal line. You now have 2 HSTs. Place them right sides together with seams butted up against each other, **making sure that you have opposite colors on each side, purple against yellow on each side**. Draw a diagonal line on the lighter fabric that crosses over the seam. Sew ¼" on either side and cut on the diagonal line. You will have two QSTs, but only one is needed in the center of the block (see pic). Here is an easy YouTube that shows making QSTs:
