
Double Slice Layer Cake 48" x 61"



The above version of this quilt has been modified adding sashing between the rows to achieve the longer length of 61". The original Missouri Star design is pictured inside with a link to their video.

Quilt size: 48" x 61"

Blocks: 20 blocks 9" x 9" finished


Setting: 4 x 5 horizontal

Inner border & Sashing between rows: 1" wide (cut 1.5")

Outer border: 5" wide (cut 5.5")

Block instructions:

This block was designed to use "Layer Cake" 10x10 pre-cut fabrics OR you can cut your own 10x10 fabric squares. Fat quarters also work well for this 10 x 10 size. For an ideal scrappy look use 20 different contrasting prints (10 will also work).



Stack several of the 10" squares lining them up carefully and rotary cut them as shown (see A above) into a 3.5" strip and a 6.5" strip. Sew both pieces back together making sure you have 2 different fabrics that contrast. Press the seams to one side.

Stack the squares ready for the second cut. Cut vertically into two 5" sections. (see B above) Take 2 different sections making sure you have fabrics that contrast, reverse the pieces (see C above) and sew back together.

Your blocks should now measure 9.5" square. Arrange the blocks as shown in the picture of the quilt, 1 horizontal and 1 vertical. This way no seams between the blocks will touch each other making if very easy to piece.
