


April BOM Puzzle Quilt Block #4 – "Mosaic #6" Block A


Option: You can use the quick method for HSTs









Fabric: Red, white & blue in Dark Lt, Medium, and Dark - choose your shades of these colors.


Piecing: Sew G triangles to F triangles, press toward dark, connect rows

Piecing: Sew small triangles to large triangles, press toward sm triangles, trim triangle points. Plain=L, Stripes=DL, Lt checks=M, Dk checks=DM



Fabric: Black (dark) & Gold (medium)
This is for 8A - 8B is different





<u>Piecing:</u> Sew large G triangles to small F triangles, press toward G on large triangles, toward dark on small triangles, trim triangle points. Connect G/F units for each quadrant, then upper and lower sections, or just connect rows.
