Hanging Kitchen Towel Instructions- Set of 2

Materials:

2- 9" X 12" Front Fabric
2-9" X 12" Back Fabric
2-9" X 12" Batting or flannel
2- 2 ½" strip of sew on Velcro

- 1- Terry Cloth Kitchen Towel, cut in half crosswise
 - 1. Cut your towel in half so there are 2 pieces approximately 14" X 18."
 - 2. Pleat, fold or gather the towel raw edge so that it measures 6" across. Baste pleats, folds, or gathers in place.
 - 3. Using the template provided, cut two pieces from fabric and one from batting for each towel.
 - 4. Lay fabric pieces right sides together and lay batting on top of fabric. Pin in place.
 - 5. Starting at point A, stitch around the handle using a ¼" seam allowance, to point B. Clip corners and turn right side out and press. Turn under a 1" hem along the open bottom end and press.
 - 6. Insert the pleated/folded/gathered raw edge of the towel into the open end of the handle so it lays a full inch inside. Sew at least two rows of stitches to hold it in place.
 - 7. On the front side of the towel, sew on the two strips of Velcro, sticky half at top, soft half at bottom (see template)
 - 8. Feel free to embellish with rick-rack or pretty fabric at the bottom of the towel.
