## LAYER CAKE STAR QUILT

## SUPPLY LIST

One Layer Cake +8-10" squares OR $31 / 2$ Yards Fabric:
>Option 1: Layer Cake: (usually 42-10" squares) PLUS enough fabric to equal 50-10" squares, which can be from matching layer cake fabric or something that coordinates.
*Blocks with a layer cake will probably be more varied than if you cut your own squares. OR
>Option 2: Fabric $31 / 2$ yards: Cut your own $50-10$ " squares in coordinated or scrappy colors. This could be from one fabric if you want your blocks all one color. See Kim's quilt photo.

Background for Stars: $31 / 2$ yards. Could be a light fabric like Kim's with dark stars, or could be dark fabric with light stars.

For Star Rectangles: Need $10021 / 2 \times 101 / 2$ rectangles for stars - See photo for ideas for your stars.
Using 42" fabric:
>Option 1:2 ${ }^{1 / 4}$ yards. Cut 7-10 $1 / 2$ " strips. Subcut into $4-10 \frac{112 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares, which are subcut into $4-2 \frac{1}{2} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles per square $=16$ rectangles per $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
[ $7 \times 16=112$ rectangles]
OR
>Option 2: JellyRoll $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}(25)$ strips or from 2 yards, cut $25-2 \frac{112 "}{}$ strips.
Subcut jellyroll or other $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips into $4-2 \frac{1}{2} \times 10^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime}$ rectangles per strip. [ $25 \times 4=100$ rectangles]

## Other Supplies:

Small cutting mat if you wish
Rotary Cutter
Straight Ruler at least $12^{\prime \prime}$ long (Star cuts will also use lines on the cutting mat)
Marking pen or chalk
Sewing machine in good working order and regular sewing notions (seam ripper, thread/bobbins, small scissors, pins/clips).
