

Turkey Block:

Background: cream color, 11" square

The main body of the turkey is a handprint. You may use your own hand for this. Using a lightweight fusible web product, trace your hand on one side of the paper. Trace the beak, wattle and feet on the paper of the lightweight fusible web. (Page 2) Cut roughly around the appliqué pieces. and remove the paper on the plain side of the cutouts and press the fusible side on the WRONG side of your fabrics. Cut out all pieces on the lines.

Lay out the pieces on the center of your background square, placing the beak, wattle and feet so that the body of the turkey overlaps slightly. When you have the pieces adjusted, iron the pieces.

Once fused, you can use whatever stitch you'd like to appliqué them to the background.
