

# Simple Squares Baby Quilt

*Finished Quilt Size: 37 1/2" x 37 1/2"*

## Materials Needed:

(16) 6 1/2" bright squares

7/8 yard of grey solid for sashing & borders

1 1/4 yards of fabric for backing

batting, 42" x 45"

4 1/2 yards of light blue rick rack

3/8 yard of navy fabric for binding

## Cutting:

### **From the grey fabric, cut:**

5 strips, 2 1/2" x 42" for the sashing;

    crosscut *two of the strips* into 12 rectangles, 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

    crosscut *three of the strips* into 3 strips, 2 1/2" x 30 1/2"

2 strips, 4" x 30 1/2" for the outer border

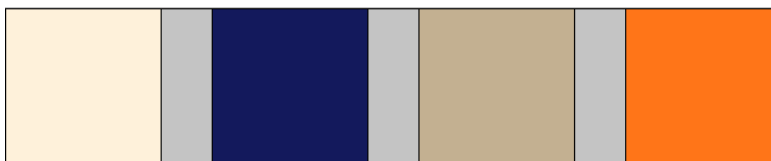
2 strips, 4" x 37 1/2" for the outer border

### **From the navy binding, cut:**

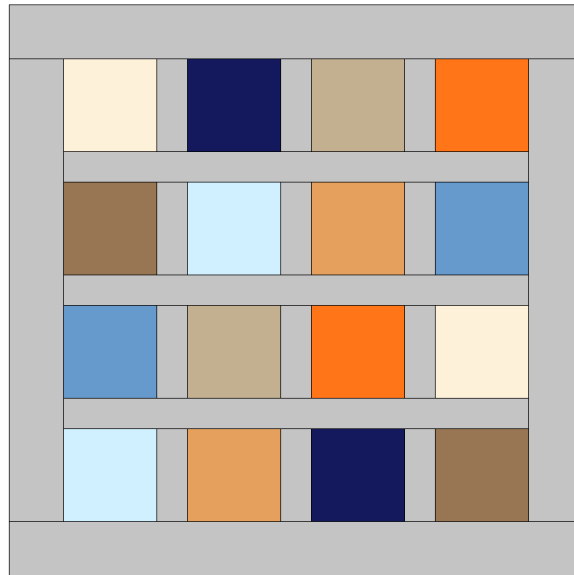
4 strips, 2 1/2" x 42"

## Quilt Top Assembly:

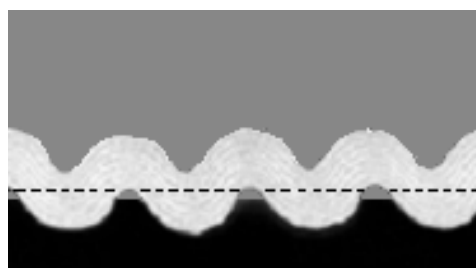
Sew together four bright 6 1/2" squares and three grey 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles to make a row. Press the seam allowances towards the sashing. Make 4.



Sew the rows together with a grey 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strip in between each row. Press the seams allowances towards the sashing. Sew a grey 4" x 30 1/2" strip to each side and a grey 4 x 37 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.



Quilt as desired. Trim off excess backing and batting. Then sew a piece of rick rack onto each side of the quilt using a 1/8" seam allowance. Trim off the excess rick rack.



1/8" Stitching Line

Bind using four 2 1/2" navy binding strips.
