

“Stars Made Simple” Quilt Class By Ruth Sielaff

Supplies

1. *Stars Made Simple* by Kaye Wood – Book is a must have, inexpensive on Amazon.
2. Sewing machine in good working order :)
3. Rotary cutter, mat and rulers. One needs to be a Hexagon – I will bring mine but you will have to wait your turn for that.
4. Pins
5. General sewing supplies.

Fabric

These measurements are for 8” hexagons

1. Focus fabric for octagons you will need a design a little smaller than the 8” hexagons. You will need a “picture” for each hexagon you make.

- One picture if it is just the place mat.
- Three pictures for the table runner /wall hanging.
- Eight pictures for the wall hanging.

Focus fabric amount will change depending on the size of the design of the fabric you choose. * Remember you will need at least 8” for each design you use. If you want to make inserts that are removable you will need 2 designs for each insert. Pictures can be seasonal, family photos, etc.

2. Contrasting fabric for “log cabin” strips. (You may want more than one color.)

- Strip 1 (next to octagon) is 1 ½ “ strip the width of fabric, for each hexagon you make.
- Strip 2 (middle strip) is 2” wide the width of fabric + 8”, for each hexagon you make.
- Strip 3 (outer strip) is 2” wide, you will need 2 width of fabric strips, for each hexagon.

3. Contrasting fabric for star points. Folded single triangles: For 8” hexagons: you will need a 4 -3/4” X 30” strip for each hexagon’s star points.

4. Placemat corners one width of fabric x 5.5” wide.
